APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & CRITERIA

- **ESSAY:** A typed essay (500 - 1,000 words) answering the following prompt:

“What makes you think you are a Republican?”

Essay should demonstrate applicant's ability to present ideas with clarity of expression and proper grammar, spelling, etc. and have originality of thought.

- **APPLICATION:** Official application (Part 1 & 2), all sections completed in full, including original signature of student and parent or guardian.
- **TRANSCRIPT:** Official copy of your most recent high school transcript, signed by your school counselor and submitted in a sealed envelope. You must be a graduating senior in the Poway Unified School District.
- **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** Two printed and signed letters of recommendation (for example: from a high school or principal, Scout leader, youth group leader, business professional, public official, etc.). Letter should include recommender's title and phone number.
- **APPLICATION PACKET**, with the above items, can be MAILED or DROPPED OFF by date indicated on the application.
 - Applications are evaluated on scholastic achievement, school activities, community activities, political activities (i.e., work on campaigns, voter registration) and overall appearance of the application.
 - Scholarships are awarded at the sole discretion of the RBRWF Scholarship Committee.

PRESENTATION OF AWARD

- Finalists may be interviewed and winner will be notified.
- The winner of the RBRWF Scholarship will be invited to attend a luncheon in Rancho Bernardo where they will receive their award and present their essay.
